KUBAS (Kent Ukulele & Banjulele Appreciation Society) Song End Flourishes


You can add a flourish to the end of a song. This can help to finish the song for your audience.

Two simple flourishes that can be used for a song that ends in the chord of **"C"** are shown below:

The "Slide"

Start with:

- Fig. 1 (single strum)
- Keep your fingers on the strings and slide down the neck to Fig. 2 (single strum)
- Keep your fingers on the strings and slide down the neck to Fig. 3 (single strum)
- Finish with Fig. 4 (C) with a strum and a pluck of the fourth string



The "I Thank You Now"

The "I Thank You Now" ending is a common ending that you will recognise.

Start with:

- Fig. 1 only pluck the third string (Note G)
- Fig. 2 only pluck the fourth open string (String A)
- Fig. 3 only pluck the third string (same a Fig. 1)
- Finish with Fig. 4 by strumming the chord (C7) several times.
