! STRINGS! (Quick Guide)

There are a variety of strings available for the ukulele.

These consist of various materials/polymers that include:

Fluorocarbon	Nylgut / Nyltech	Nylon
Titanium	Steel	Wound Nylon

A set of strings can cost from £3.00 to £15.00 depending upon the quality.

The strings are manufactured in different thicknesses.

They are also available in different tuning depending upon the size of your ukulele e.g. "C" tuning (GCEA) or "D" tuning (ADF#B) with Low and Hi "G" options available.

Each material can be processed to harden or soften the string.

The string can also be coloured to create a different tone and resonance.

The string can sound different on different instruments that are manufactured in various sizes and different woods.

The string reacts also to temperature and humidity that can affect the tone.

Below are a few popular strings that may be fitted to your instrument:



Why not experiment with different strings to see how they sound with your style of playing and with your instrument.
