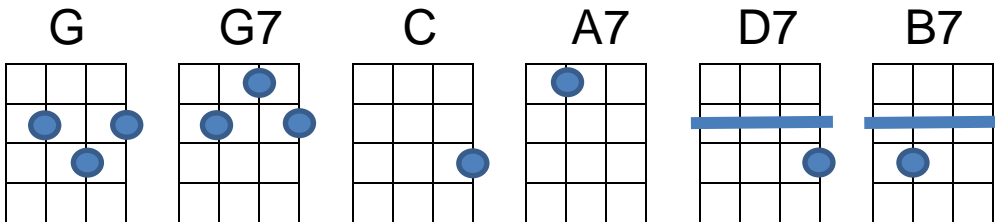


Show Me The Way To Go Home
