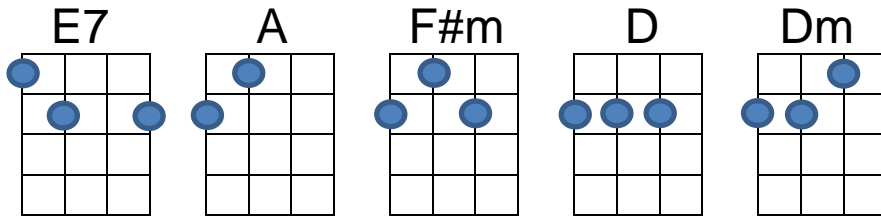

But you (Dm) know you're not dreaming, (A) signoré,
