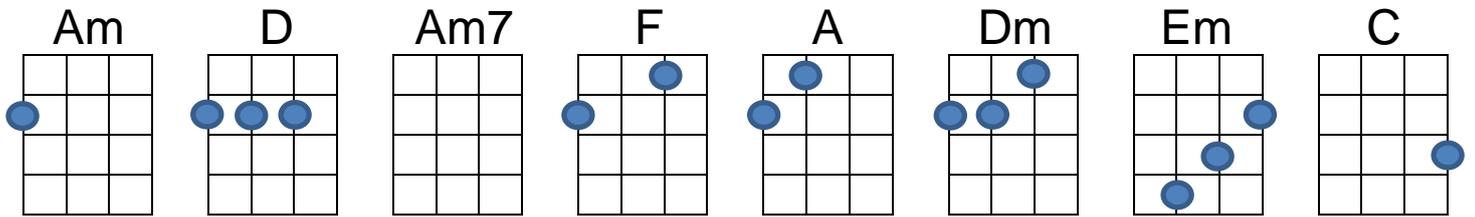


She's Not There
