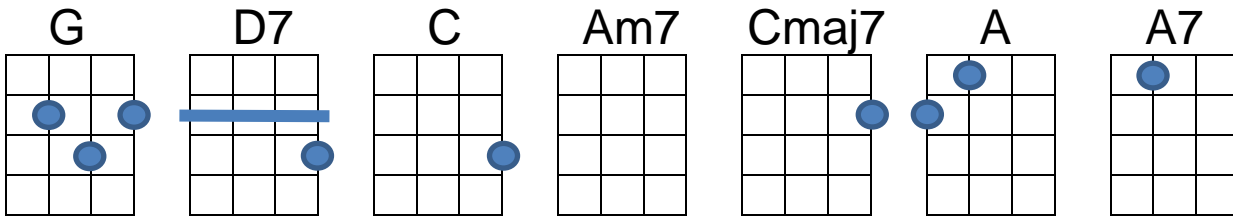


Then I Kissed Her
