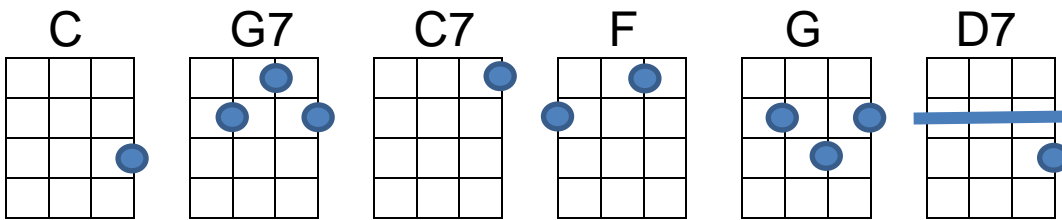


## Oh Lonesome Me
