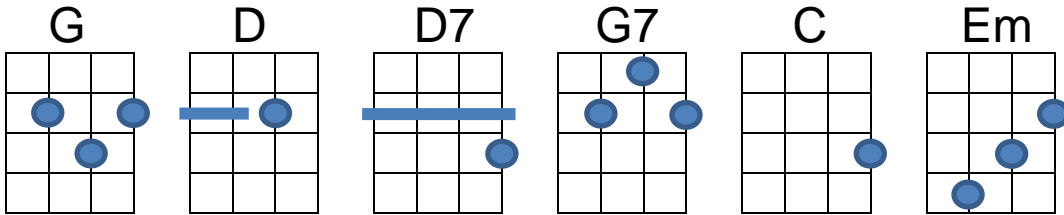


Ob-La-Di – Ob-La-Da
